Personal information which we collect from you

Security

We employ security measures to protect your information from access by unauthorised persons and to guard against unlawful processing, accidental loss, destruction and damage and we will do our best to ensure that all records we hold remain secure in line with our obligations under Data Protection Acts, 1988 and 2003. Retention

We do not retain your personal data for longer than it is necessary for us to comply with the purpose for which you gave it to us. Photographs of pupils' work are usually on the website for the duration of the academic year. Thereafter they are deleted from the website. Other photos of groups of pupils involved in school events may be archived to create an historical record of life at the school. They are also stored securely on a school data storage device during the lifetime of the pupils' time at All Saints' National School.

Accessing Your Information

You are entitled to see the information we hold about you. On written request, we supply copies of your personal data which you may have supplied to us using our website. If you wish to obtain copies of this personal data, you should write to the principal of All Saints' National school, Doohamlet, Castleblayney, Co. Monaghan and ask that he/she provides you with an Access Request Form. Your request will be dealt with as soon as possible and will not take more than 40 days to process. If you discover that All Saints' National School holds inaccurate information about you, you can request that we correct that information. In certain circumstances, you may also request that data which you have supplied via our website be deleted (although you should note that if you request a deletion, you would generally be expected to identify some contravention of data protection law in the manner in which All Saints' National School processes the data concerned). Upon written request, we will supply you with a Data Rectification/Erasure Form for this purpose.
